

Photographic Competition Rules

- Three submissions per person
- Accepting **digital and print** submissions
- Creative licence is allowed.
- Open to all amateur and professional photographers of all ages
- Photographs will be judged by a team of three judges. Photographers agree to let the Uniting Church Northbridge use both their photograph and their name on the Church website and in all publications.
- Photographs must be accompanied by the name of the photographer and contact details including email address and phone number.
- Photographs must be **JPEG format**.
- The file size per photo must not exceed **4MB**, not less than **500KB**.

YOUR RIGHTS

You will retain all rights to any photograph you submit —other than those rights licensed in the next sentence. By entering the contest, you hereby grant to the Uniting Church Northbridge (i) a nonexclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free license to reproduce, distribute, and publicly display the photographs you submit to the Uniting Church Northbridge, and (ii) the right to use your name in promotions and other publications.

WHAT TO ENTER

We are looking for digital images highlighting the chosen theme. Entrants must not submit images that infringe on the rights of any other photographer or person.

HOW TO ENTER

All images must be submitted with the applicant's/photographer's first and last name.

All photographs on the Northbridge-CastleCrag Uniting Church website will be numbered and have the name of the photographer. If you include people in your photographic submission, you must obtain proper releases from those individuals, and you must be able to provide the Uniting Church Northbridge with originals of those releases at any time that the Church requests.
